## *Devotion for February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022*

*"And [the master of the feast] said to him, 'Everyone serves the good wine first, and when people have drunk freely, then the poor wine. But you have kept the good wine until now.' This, the first of His signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested His glory. And His disciples believed in Him."*

*- John 2:10-11*

**The quote above is what the master of the feast said when he drank the first of the water that Jesus turned into wine.** During the feast of the wedding of Cana they ran out of wine. At the request of Mary, his mother, Jesus turned six stone jars full of about 20 gallons of water (120 gallons) into wine. It wasn't just any wine, but wine that tasted superior to the best wine they started with and even after drinking the first wine "freely". So, it wasn't just plain old ordinary stuff, but the good wine. Jesus made it known to the servants who filled the jars and to His disciples who He was, the Son of God. Who else could turn 120 gallons of water into really good wine at a moment's notice?

Jesus did many other signs or miracles to show who He was and is. Here are a few signs the apostle John wrote about. John even stated that the signs he wrote about weren't a complete list.

Here is what John wrote:

*"Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these [signs] are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name." (John 20:30-31)*

- Jesus turned water into wine at the wedding at Cana

- Jesus walked on water
- Jesus healed a paralytic at the pool of Bethesda
- Jesus gave sight to a blind man who was blind from his birth
- Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead

(This is not a complete list of the signs John wrote about.)

Is there really any doubt of who Jesus is? Who could do what He did?

We are certain that Jesus is the Son of God by the firsthand accounts of John and the other apostles present for the signs or miracles He performed. The question is, how do I respond? His disciples believed as the Bible states, do I also believe?

If I believe, then good works like good wine will come from my heart, changed by Jesus like water into wine to the benefit of those around me, just like the good wine at the wedding at Cana.
